Greetings Southern Colorado Golfers! The 31st FORE! Education Golf Tournament is returning and we hope that you will plan to join us at the Pueblo Country Club on August 28! Due to COVID-19, there are a few changes being enacted for this year's tournament.

- In order to accommodate the need for social distancing, we will be running two flights for this year's event: Flight 1 from 8
 am-noon and Flight 2 from 2–6 pm. Please indicate flight preference on the reverse side. Flight scheduling will be assigned
 on a first-come-first-served basis.
- There will be **no on-site registration** for this year's event. Sponsors and players must pay and give all golfer names prior to arriving on August 28. All registration supplies will be pre-loaded into assigned golf carts.
- Each foursome will have two golf carts. Golfers playing in the tournament may share a cart if they sign a waiver. Golfers will
 proceed to their assigned hole to start the round. No social gathering allowed.
- All food will be **grab-and-go style**. Gourmet lunch boxes will be provided to both flights of golfers: after play for Flight 1 and before play for Flight 2.

We hope that you understand the above changes are dictated by local and state social distancing requirements.
